Data Submission Funding

Every clinic contracted with OSAH receives a minimum \$11,000 per annum for data collection and reporting

1. \$2500 – Clinic operational plan in September, Midyear progress report in December, End of year progress report in May
2. \$1500 – Comprehensive risk screen reporting
3. \$5000 – report on 7 performance measures in progress reports; monthly encounter data submission
4. \$1000 - \$3000 depending on school size and productivity– Student satisfaction surveys on 10% of students seen in clinic
5. \$1000 -\$3000 depending on school size and productivity– School survey
 - a. Student body < 600: minimum respondents
 - i. 3 teachers
 - ii. Principal
 - iii. 1 other staff member, e.g., administrator, secretary, resource office, counselor, nurse
 - b. Student body 600-1000: minimum respondents
 - i. 5 teachers
 - ii. principal
 - iii. 2 other staff members, e.g., administrator, secretary, resource office, counselor, nurse
 - c. Student body >1000: minimum respondents
 - i. 7 teachers
 - ii. principal
 - iii. 3 other staff members, e.g., administrator, secretary, resource office, counselor, nurse

Operational support funding

\$40,000 per year - Level 1 – Minimum 12 hours of clinical service per week x 40 weeks – Minimum 4 hours of each PC and BH, other hours maybe combined as indicated to meet student need

\$55,000– Level 2 – Minimum 24 hours of clinical service per week x 40 weeks – Minimum 8 hours of each PC and BH, other hours maybe combined as indicated to meet student need

\$70,000- Level 3 – Minimum 40 hours of clinical service per week x 40 weeks– Minimum 15 hours of each PC and BH, other hours maybe combined as indicated to meet student need

Level	Base Funding Amount	Minimum Student Population Being Served	Minimum Combined Clinical Service Hours per Week
1	40,000	any	At least 12 combined primary care and behavioral health hours per week with a minimum of 4 hours of primary care and 4 hours of behavioral health
2	55,000	any	At least 24 combined primary care and behavioral health hours with a minimum of 8 hours of primary care and 8 hours of behavioral health
3	70,000	900	At least 40 combined primary care and behavioral health hours per week with at least 15 hours of primary care and 15 hours of behavioral health

Extra Funding

Depending on availability of funding:

Up to 10% additional operational funding for consistent provision of health services in federally designated health professional shortage areas.

20% additional operational funding for maintaining summer hours at 50% or greater of school year hours

10% additional operational funding for maintaining summer hours between 20% and 50% of school year hours during summer
